



### ***Making a bequest to the Orienteering Foundation***

If you are drawing up a new will then you can easily make a bequest to the Orienteering Foundation.

If you already have a will, you can still help the Orienteering Foundation by adding a "codicil" to your existing will (codicils are used for minor amendments to wills) with details of the bequest to the Orienteering Foundation. Alternatively you can have your will redrawn with the bequest to the Orienteering Foundation in it as above.

In either case, complete the appropriate section on page 2 (new will) or page 3 (codicil) of this document with the information requested, crossing out those options that are not required. Take the form to consult with your solicitor or legal adviser, and get the final will or codicil signed and witnessed.

Please do not write on or amend your current Will directly, or it could become invalid.

***Text to insert into a new Will***
